The **Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteer Patrol** (S.A.V.P.) is a team of citizens who enhance vital crime prevention services and community awareness through proactive law enforcement principles.

Volunteer Patrol members do not take enforcement action, carry weapons, or make arrests. All suspicious activity is reported to the local Sheriff's Office via the patrol vehicle radio.

The Volunteer Patrol Program is designed for the citizen who has an interest in helping law enforcement and the community.

A Volunteer Patrol member will attend a comprehensive training course and receive instruction in the following topics:

- Orientation and Organization
- Crime Prevention
- CPR and First Aid
- Legal Issues
- Driver Awareness
- Patrol and Observation Procedures
- Traffic Control
- Radio and Communications

## REQUIREMENTS

- Pass background check
- Graduate from SAVP Academy
- Attend Volunteer Patrol meetings
- Volunteer 8 hours per month
- Appear professional at all times
- No weapons can be carried on-duty
